

The Hyde County Board of Commissioners met at 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday April 5, 2022. Present were Robert Bawdon, Chairman; Mel Buchheim-via phone, Kevin Baloun-via phone, Ronald VanDenBerg, Greg Swenson-via phone. Also present: Emily Sovell-via phone, Carrie Stephenson, Nora Schlegel, and Cash Anderson.

Chairman Bawdon called the meeting to order. Motion to approve agenda by VanDenBerg, second by Buchheim. Roll call vote with all voting aye, motion carried.

The Board reviewed a letter to the PUC stating concerns regarding the proposed Summit Carbon Solutions CO2 Pipeline, along with an Application for Party Status (HP22-001). Discussion was held regarding filing for Party Status. Motion by Buchheim to file Application for Party Status HP22-001 with the PUC, second by VanDenBerg. Roll call vote with all voting aye, motion carried. Application, letter, and copy of Hyde County Resolution #2022-011 (moratorium on pipeline construction pending zoning updates) will be e-filed with the PUC.

Sovell and the Board held a brief discussion regarding the Application for Party Status.
