

The Hyde County Board of Equalization convened at 10:04 a.m. on Tuesday April 12, 2022. Present were Greg Swenson Vice Chairman, Mel Buchheim, and Kevin Baloun. Ronald VanDenBerg and Robert Bawdon were absent. Also present: Carrie Stephenson, Director of Equalization.

Swenson called the meeting to order.

Motion to approve agenda by Buchheim, second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried.

All members of the Board signed Board of Equalization Oath of Office.

The Board reviewed the Hyde County Statutory Exempt Property List for 2022.

Assessor Stephenson gave a brief report on 2022 values, building permits, soil survey, and the Ag Land average for Hyde County. There was a slight increase in Ag land and less growth than the previous year. Stephenson reported that there were no appeals for 2022. Hyde County had 2 applications for Elderly /Disabled Assessment Freeze and 1 application for Disabled Veteran Property Tax Exemption. Motion to approve (2) applications for Elderly/Disabled Assessment Freeze by Buchheim, second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Baloun, second by Buchheim to approve (1) application for Disabled Veteran Property Tax Exemption. All in favor, motion carried. Hyde County had 1 Flooded Land Application, motion to approve by Buchheim, second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried. Total County Value for 2022: \$781,455,088.

Brief discussion was held regarding assessments and appeals.
