

The Hyde County Board of Commissioners met at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday August 2, 2022. Present were Robert Bawdon, Chairman; Mel Buchheim, Kevin Baloun, Ronald VanDenBerg, and Greg Swenson.

Chairman Bawdon called the meeting to order. Motion to approve agenda by VanDenBerg, second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried.

The Board reviewed July Commissioner meeting minutes (3), Weed Board minutes, Library Board minutes, and fuel quotes for August- #2 Red [5000gal@\\$4.097](#) , Ethanol (87 Octane) [1000gal@\\$3.317](#) - Hall Oil & Gas. Motion to approve by Buchheim, second by Swenson. All in favor, motion carried. All Reports are on file in the County Auditor's office.

SHERIFF: Nathen Brady met with the Commissioners. Discussion was held regarding juveniles driving side by sides around town with no supervision, juveniles riding 4 wheelers in town, speeding in town, and upgrade to the radio system. Brady has not purchased a dash camera for the Sheriff's pickup. No applications have been received for the Deputy Sheriff job. The Board decided to run the statewide ad for another month. Brief discussion was held regarding blocking traffic for funeral processions. Brady reported that he had moved into his house in town.

WEED: Dave Tatum met with the Board. Tatum reported on spraying, repairs, possible enforcements, and prairie dog issues.

ROAD & BRIDGE: Jon Dean met with the Commissioners. Dean reported on road conditions, gravel hauling, various repairs, mowing, tire purchases, construction project on 47/26, and possibly having road grader training. The Board reviewed approach applications (3). Motion to approve by Swenson, second by Buchheim. All in favor, motion carried. Brian Bast was offered and accepted one of the highway jobs available. He will start work August 17. The Board reviewed (2) applications for the highway positions. Interviews will be set for Wednesday August 3, 6 pm at the highway shop. Baloun and VanDenBerg will attend interviews. Discussion was held regarding quotes for loaders, getting rid of one of the old loaders, and radios.

BUDGET: Discussion was held regarding cuts that were made at the July 25, 2022 meeting. 2023 Budget will be reviewed before adopting the Annual budget in September.
