

The Hyde County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 p.m. on Monday July 25, 2022. Present were Robert Bawdon, Chairman; Mel Buchheim, Kevin Baloun, and Ronald VanDenBerg. Greg Swenson joined the meeting at 7:42 p.m.

Chairman Bawdon called the meeting to order. Motion to approve agenda by Buchheim, second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried.

BUDGET: The revised version of the 2023 budget was reviewed after preliminary cuts. The budget was calculated with a 5% raise for all employees. Additional cuts had to be made to the R&B budget in order to balance with the cash that is estimated to be carried over from 2022.

ROAD & BRIDGE: Discussion was held regarding hiring a new employee for the Highway Department. There are 3 positions being advertised as "open until filled". Motion by Baloun, second by VanDenBerg to offer one of the jobs to Applicant #1 at \$18.50 per hour. Applicant #1 had previously applied, interviewed, and been offered a job with the County but declined the offer. All in favor, motion carried. Baloun will contact Applicant #1.

Motion was made by Buchheim to adjourn at 8:01 p.m., second by Baloun. All in favor, motion carried. Next regular meeting is Tuesday August 2, 2022 at 8:30 a.m.
